WHAT IS STATE TESTING?

Measurements of Student Progress (MSP)

The MSP name conveys the goal of the test: to measure student progress. State testing should never be the sole judge of a student's academic skills and knowledge, as his/her entire academic performance should always be considered. The reading, math and science MSP includes multiple-choice and short answer questions. Fourth grade includes two writing prompts for the students to address.

Grades 3-5 *Reading and Math*
Grade 4 *Writing*
Grade 5 *Science*
