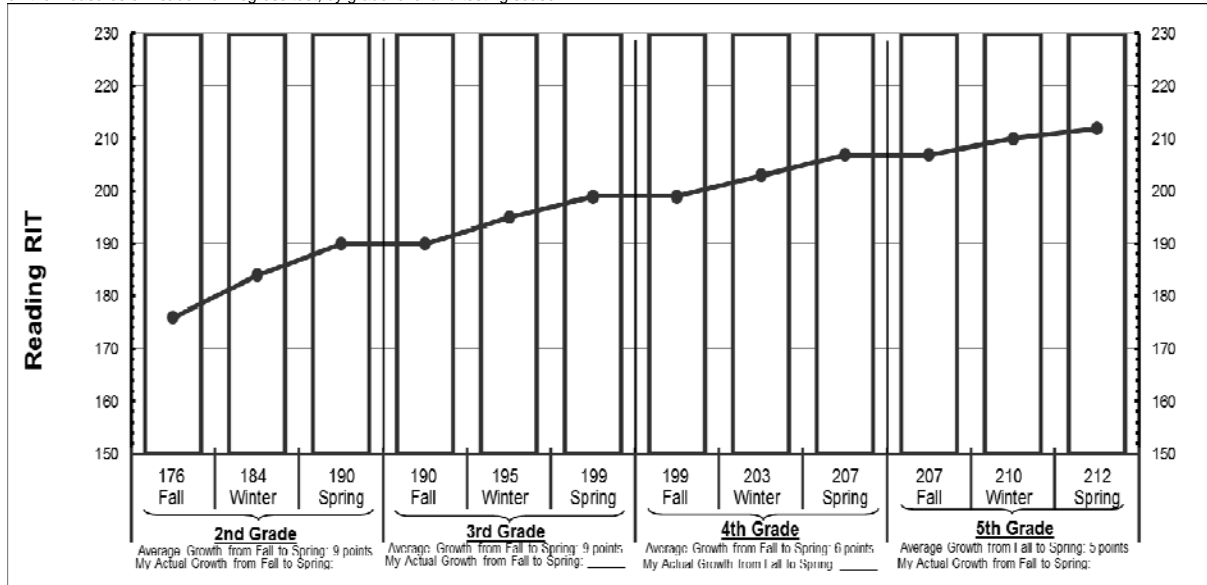

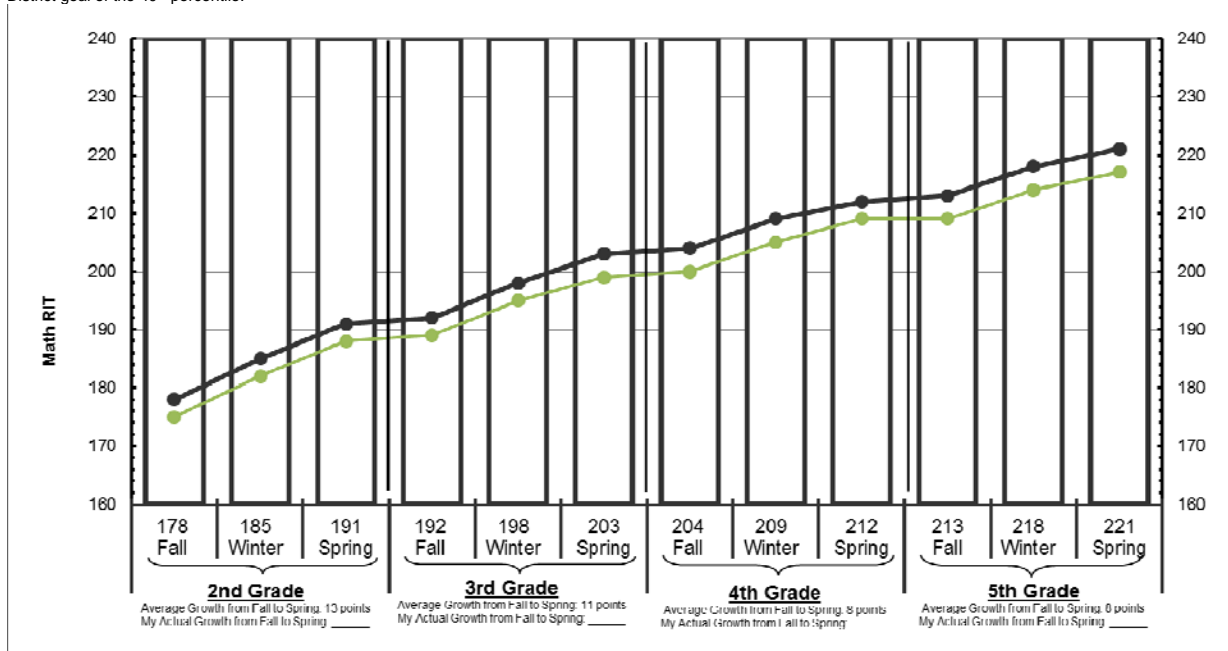
The line graph on the chart below is at the 50th percentile in Reading on the Measures of Academic Progress test, by grade level and testing season

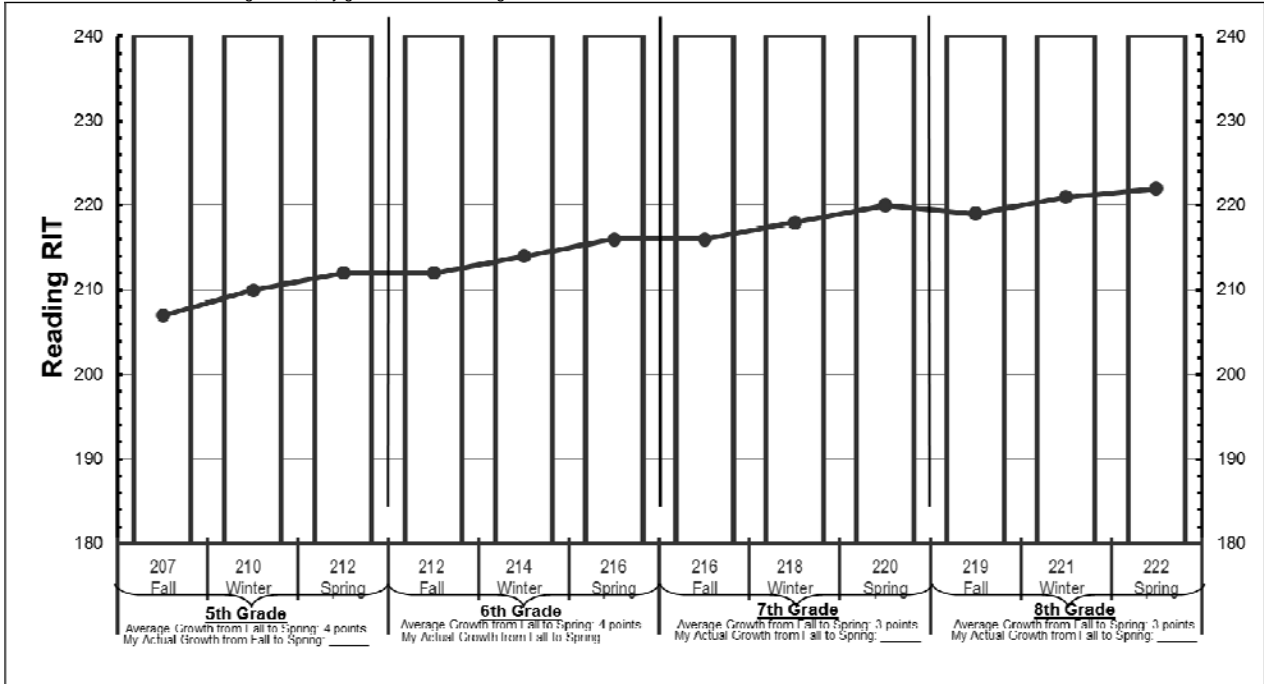

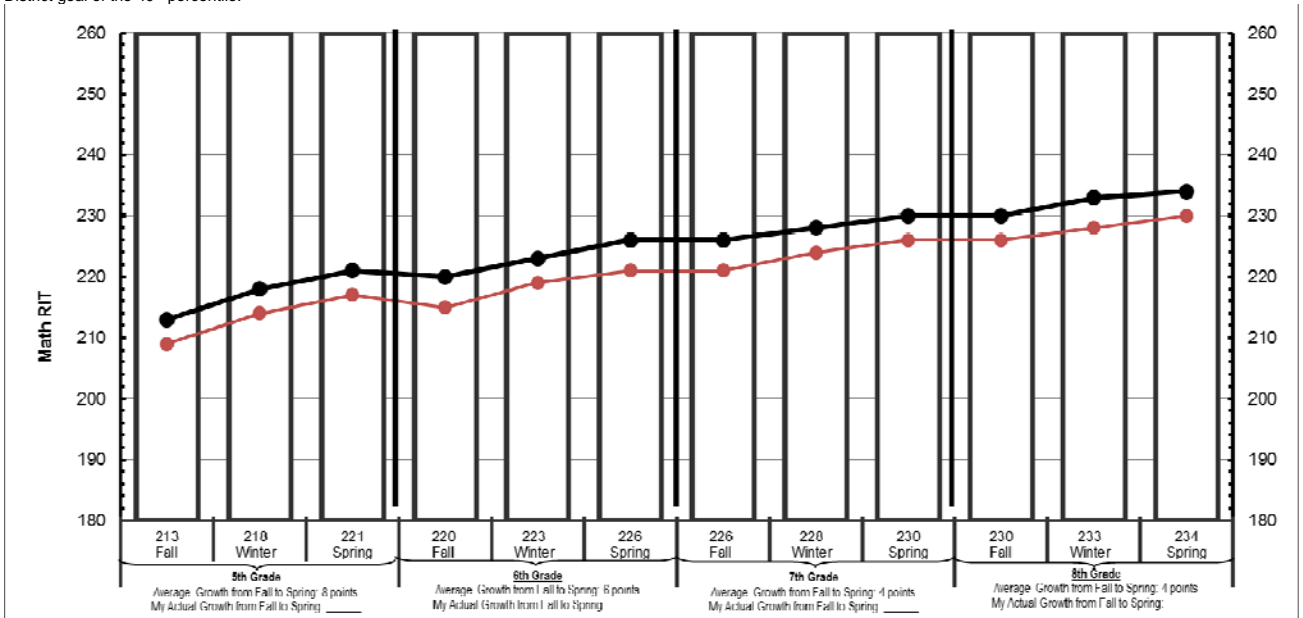

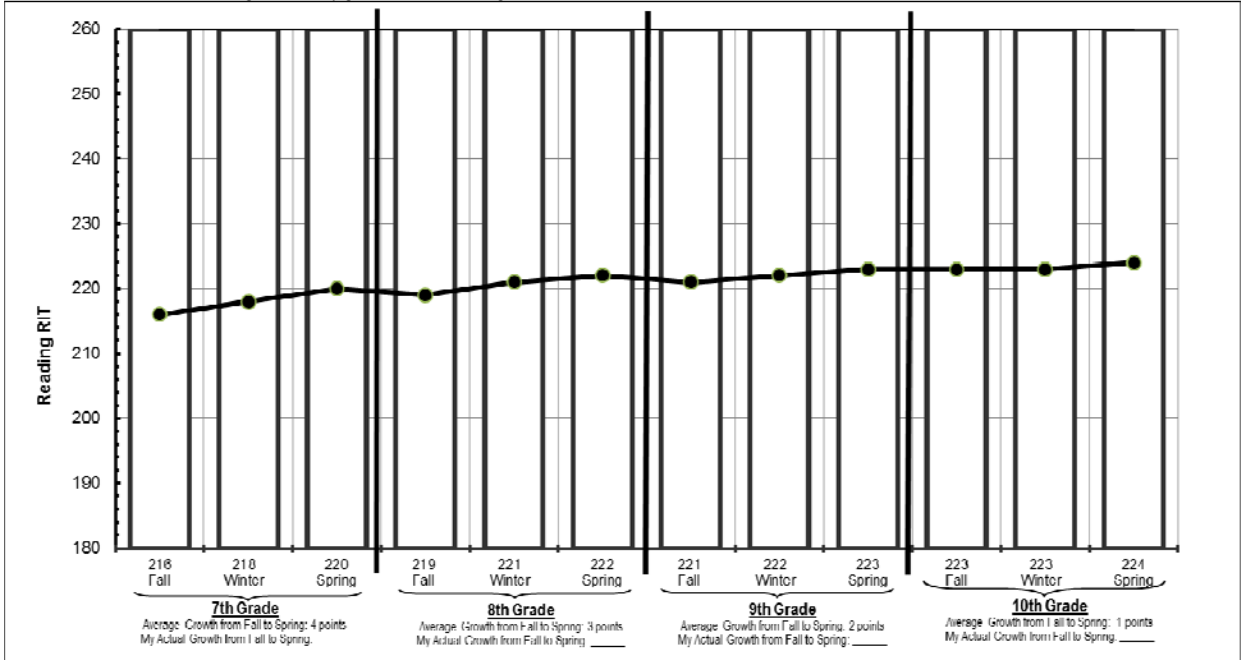

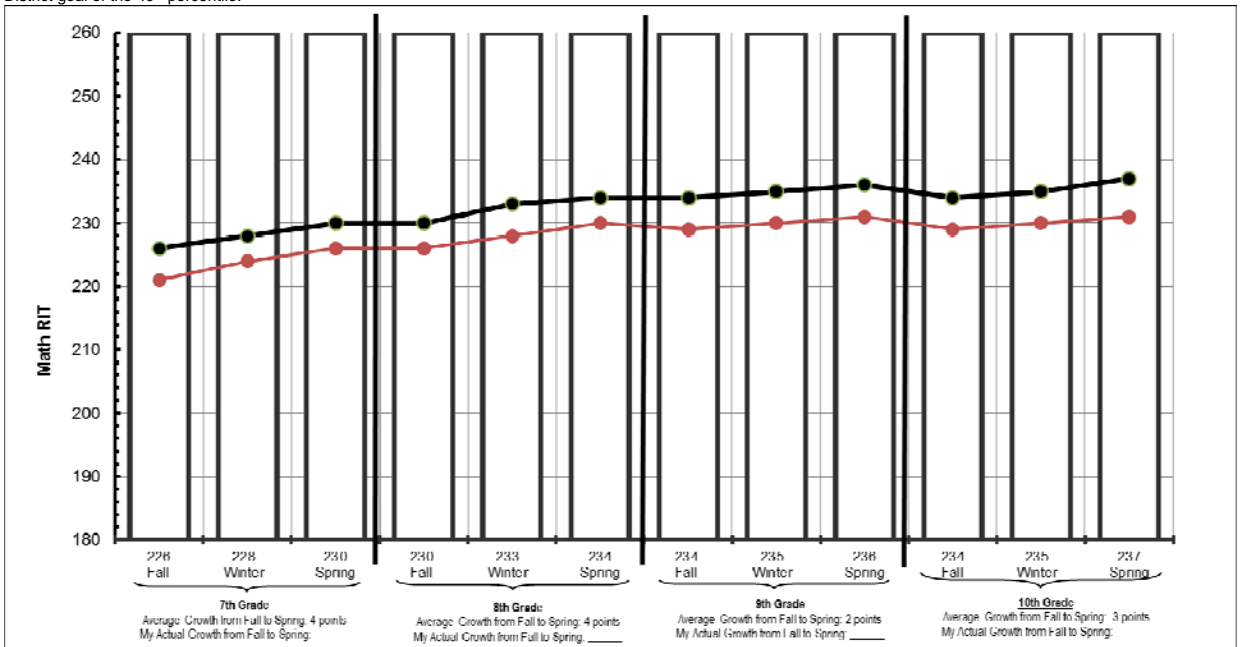
The line graph on the chart below is at the 50th percentile in Reading on the Measures of Academic Progress test, by grade level and testing season
