## NON-INSTRUCTIONAL OPERATIONS

## Student Conduct on Buses

The superintendent shall establish written rules of conduct for students riding school buses which shall as a minimum include:

- 1. Identification of the individual who has authority over the passengers.
- 2. Student riding privileges.
- 3. Procedures prior to loading, e.g., student must cross the highway only in front and never behind school bus.
- 4. Loading and unloading procedures and seat assignments.
- 5. Student conduct.
- 6. Acceptable practices with respect to talking, moving around the bus, use of windows, and other behavior.
- 7. Unacceptable hazards that may cause injury to others, e.g., firearms, breakable containers, etc.
- 8. Bus cleanliness.
- 9. Emergency exit procedures.

A copy of the rules of conduct for students riding buses will be provided to all students at the beginning of the year. The classroom teacher and bus driver will review the rules with the students at or near the beginning of each school year. A copy of the rules will be posted in each bus and will be available upon request at the district office and all school offices.
