The "No Child Left Behind" Act requires parents of English Language Learners (ELL) participating in Washington's Transitional Bilingual Instruction Program or Title III program to be notified each year of Annual Measurable Achievement Objectives (AMAO) for the school district.

Below is a description of each AMAO target:

AMAO-1: Annual increases in the number or percentage of children making progress in learning English.

AMAO-2: Annual increases in the number or percentage of children attaining English proficiency.

AMAO-3: The number or percentage of students meeting Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) targets in reading and math on the state assessments.
