Student Immunization and Life Threatening Health Conditions

Procedures for Life Threatening Conditions

Student Enrolls in School:

1. Upon enrollment parent/guardian completes health history form.
2. Nurse/secretary/data processor/registrar reviews health history form life threatening conditions.
3. If a life threatening condition is indicated on the form the school nurse will be contacted.
4. The registration will be held until the school nurse is able to complete follow up work with the family.
5. If the student is determined to have a life threatening condition before attending school the Individual Health Plan must be completed and:
 - a. All medications/treatment plan need to be current and at school
 - b. Any needed staff training must be completed
 - c. Any other needed element of the plan must be in place
6. All Individual Health Care Plans will be reviewed annually.
7. All medication/treatment plans will be current at the beginning of the school year.
8. Students with Individual Health Care Plans that are not updated annually may not attend school until plans and medications are current.
