

INSTRUCTION**Certificate of Educational Competence (GED)**

Those students in the Kennewick School District between the ages of 16 and 19 years of age who have a warranted need for seeking a certificate of educational competence shall make application through the building principal who, upon approving their request, will refer them to the General Educational Development Test Center.

The award of the GED certificate shall not preclude a person (21 or under) from applying to return to high school if factors that warranted the original application are changed. A Review Committee will evaluate the application to return and make a recommendation to the building principal.
