

INSTRUCTIONPrayer and Devotional Activities

As a matter of individual liberty, a student may, of his/her own volition, engage in private, unobtrusive prayer whenever he/she wishes to do so. School staff shall neither encourage nor discourage a student from engaging in prayer or any other form of devotional activity so long as it is not disruptive to the normal processes of the school.
