Who now occupies the Kennewick School District Administration Center?

The administration center now houses all of the departments from the Auburn and Dayton Street buildings including; Payroll, Human Resources, Business Office, Information Technology, Curriculum, Elementary and Secondary Education, Career and Technical Education, Special Services, Migrant/Bilingual Services, Federal Programs, Early Childhood Education Assistance Program, Community Education, Facilities Scheduling, Communications, and the Superintendent's Office.

How will the Kennewick School District Administration Center Benefit the District and the Community?

The new administration center now brings many of the district's departments under one roof in an improved working environment. There are several rooms available for staff development, trainings, and meetings. These rooms, along with office and workspaces, have the electrical and data systems capacity to handle current technology. These rooms will also be available to the community to reserve for meetings. With nearly 9,000 square feet of expansion space available, this facility will fill the needs of the district and community for many years to come.

Old Auburn Building

Auburn Bldg Sq Footage: 17,575

10,000 sq. ft. built 1954 and 7,575 sq. ft. added in 1972

Old Dayton Street Building

Dayton Bldg Sq Footage: 34,852

Includes 16,352 sq. ft. in modular units relocated from Hanford site in early 1960s. These units are estimated to have been constructed in 1940's.

How much of the \$68 million dollar bond went into this project?

We projected to use \$2.0M of bond proceeds with the remaining balance coming from a combination of District funds held in our capital fund and excess state matching funds received on elementary construction projects.
