### 2011-2012 Tutoring information

Supplemental Educational Services (SES) provided at no cost to you!

Federally funded services are being offered to the following elementary schools; Amistad, Eastgate, Edison, and Westgate and Park Middle School students who qualify for free or reduced-price lunch because those schools have not made "adequate yearly progress" according to a federal definition for two years in a row.

### **What are Supplemental Educational Services?**

Supplemental Educational Services provide academic enrichment in reading, language arts and/or math outside the school day – that is, before or after school, on weekends, during breaks, or during the summer at no cost to families. The SES sessions are high quality, research-based, and specifically designed to increase the academic achievement of eligible students.

If sufficient funds are not available to serve all students who are eligible, the Kennewick School District must give priority to the lowest-achieving eligible students.

### **Who is eligible?**

Students from Amistad, Eastgate, Edison, Westgate and Park Middle School who qualify for free or reduced-price lunch are eligible to apply for tutoring for the 2011-12 school year.

### **How do I apply?**

Fill out and return to your child's school the application mailed home previously or you can pick up an application at your student's school.

### **Who provides the tutoring?**

If transportation to the tutoring site is required, it is the parents' responsibility.
