Families who qualified for free or reduced price meal benefits during the 2008-2009 school year remain qualified for those benefits during the first 30 school days of the 2009-2010 school year. This gives families a chance to submit their application for free or reduced meals until late September to turn in their paperwork.

Forms are available in your child's school and the Nutrition Services Department office (address above). These forms can be mailed in the postage paid envelope inserted in the application or in person at the Nutrition Services Department office. School districts' have 10 business days to process an application from the time it is received. Families whose applications have not been approved for the current school year by October 12, 2009 will revert to full paid meals status and will be responsible to pay for all meals their students consume from that day until another application is approved.
