



PURPOSE & OVERVIEW

MISSION STATEMENT: Preparing students for a positive and successful life after high school.

ADVISORY:

PORTFOLIO:

- Due prior to Student-Led Conferences.
- Provides a place to keep track of academic progress, school and community involvement, and graduation requirements.
- Resource for students to use when applying for jobs, college and future career opportunities.
- Showcases student's hard work to their parents and advisors.

STUDENT-LED CONFERENCE:

- Will be held in the month of March.
- Conference is led by the student.
- Student presents their portfolio to their advisor and their parents.
- The presentation includes a discussion of achievements and goals.
- The student will work together with their parents and advisor to register for their classes the following year.
