Here at Southridge the coaches, players, and parents are committed to the program. Parents have a lot to do with how committed their son's are. Last year we had to cancel some J.V. games, because too many people were absent, that was not fair to the other players on the team.

WASL is in the spring, therefore there are two weeks in which we do not play games. This means we have three games during spring break. We ask that you do not leave or vacation during this week. If your son leaves this just gives an opportunity to the next player to take his spot.

We also hold a Mini-Sun soccer camp as a fund raiser for players K-5th grade during Spring Break. The players are the instructors so we need them there.

There are three things we as a coaching staff look for in a player:

You can see they all go together, if a player works hard he will be committed to what we are trying to achieve, and his skill will then get better.

Some years there have been as many as six players moved from J.V. that started in a Varsity game.
