

STUDENTSFreedom of Assembly

During normal school hours individual students and student organizations may meet in school rooms or auditoriums, or at outdoor locations on school grounds, to discuss, pass resolutions, and take other lawful action respecting any matter which directly or indirectly concerns or affects them, whether or not it relates to school. Such activities must have prior approval of the principal and shall not be permitted to interfere with the normal operation of the school.

After school hours assembly on school property must follow procedures set forth in the district rental agreement.

The principal's prior approval will allow time to properly screen the activities. The use of all school facilities shall conform to the normal socially accepted student activities. Permission for the use of facilities for meetings may be denied when in the opinion of the principal such activities are not in the best overall interests of the district.
