**EARLY GRADUATION APPLICATION**

Kennewick School District Policy Number 2413 permits students who have “accumulated twenty-one (21) credits and successfully completed the requirements of the District and the State...” to graduate early from high school.

A student wishing to be considered for early graduation must make application to the principal through the counseling department at least one semester prior to the requested graduation date. Principals may waive the “one semester prior” requirement under unique circumstances.
